Pomacentridae. Thirty species are recognized: one in the genus *Premnas*, while the remaining are in the genus *Amphiprion*. In the wild, they all form symbiotic mutualisms with sea anemones. Depending on species, anemonefish are overall yellow, orange, or a reddish or blackish color, and many show white bars or patches.
